Grounds and Maintenance Report—Annual Meeting 2025 (Liliane Benucci, Tisa Houck, Lorin Myers, Rene'e Weber, Susan & Steve Woodard, John Chant committee members)

In addition to overseeing the work done by Clean Cuts Landscaping (CCL), the Committee handled the following projects from January to November 2025: Reported all streetlight outages to Duke Energy, including the outages at the 17 entrance after hurricane Milton interrupted power to the entrance signs and median lights.

Monitored irrigation functions at both entrances and reported any necessary repairs to CCL.

Monitored the operation of both fountains.

Contracted the removal of a fallen tree at the top of Lancaster Rd.

Contracted pressure washing of all areas of the walking trail, wooden bridge, brick walls at the 17 entrance, and the sign at the 15A entrance. Sealant was applied to the bridge. Contracted to have all four Brandywine entrance signs repainted.

Contacted Volusia County Road & Bridge to remove tree branches that were impeding traffic and to remove vegetation around a storm drain and clear the drain.

Assessed each cul-de-sac and had mulch applied where necessary.

Contacted the condo association about maintaining the north side of the 17 entrance from Village Green Rd. to the Brandywine sign, which is their responsibility. Contacted the City of DeLand about maintaining the shrubbery surrounding the lift station on Burgoyne Rd. The City agreed that this area is their responsibility. NOTE: Work was done to replace the weir and assess the function of the drainage system that connects all 3 ponds. The Board conducted the inspections and will handle this major project in the near future
